The Jackson Area MPO has prepared an amendment to the FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following Projects:

- TIP# JAX Local 6-3- Airways Phase I (TDOT PIN =132939.00)
- TIP# JAX Local 6-4- Airways Phase II (TDOT PIN = 133572.00)

The detailed TIP project sheet and MPO Board resolution are attached for reference. Based on funding information provided by TDOT, the MPO has determined that the TIP remains fiscally constrained. WHEREAS, Airways Phase I and Phase II projects have not been programmed in the 2020-2023 TIP previously

WHEREAS, A public meeting was held in accordance with the approved Public Participation Plan, and proper notice of the meeting was given; and

WHEREAS, The MPO Technical Staff has reviewed and considered the amendment to the FY 2020-2023 TIP and any public comments received and has recommended approval of the amendment by the Executive Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Executive Board of the Jackson Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) does hereby approve the amendment to the Fiscal Years 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).


