Call to Order, Invocation, & Pledge and Roll Call:

The Council of the City of Jackson met in Special Call session on Tuesday, November 10, 2020, at 9:00 am. Mayor Scott Conger called the meeting to order and lead us in the invocation and Allegiance Pledge. The Mayor then called the roll. Councilmembers Ernest Brooks II, David Cisco, Johnny Dodd, Russ McKelvey, Gary Pickens, Ross Priddy, Paul Taylor, and Marda Wallace were present. Harvey Buchanan was absent. First Readings:

1. Consideration of a Proposed Budget Amendment for \$525,000 for settlement related to Cox v. City of Jackson (1:01 – 2:10)

Councilmember Brooks made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dodd, to approve the agenda item as submitted. The Mayor asked if anyone had a public comment; there was none. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, except Councilmember Cisco voting nay; motion passed 7 – 1.

1. Consideration of acceptance of settlement terms in Cox v. City of Jackson (2:12 – 35:18)

Councilmember Dodd made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Brooks, to approve the agenda item as submitted. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, except Councilmember Cisco voting nay; motion passed 7 – 1.
