CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, PLEDGE, AND ROLL CALL (00:00 – 00:49)

The Council of the City of Jackson met in a special call session on Monday, February 7, 2022, at 8:00 am. Mayor Scott Conger called the meeting to order and led us in the invocation and Allegiance Pledge. The Mayor then called the roll. Consideration of a Resolution to adopt a Plan of Service, an Ordinance to annex, and the proposed zoning of property referred to as "Tall Oaks-Freeman," submitted by the City of Jackson, on behalf of Tall Oak Farms, LP and William D. Freeman and Rebecca H. Freeman Revocable Living Trust, comprising 236.99 acres, more or less, located at Fiberglass Road, Anglin Road, Lower Brownsville Road and State Route 223. The proposed zoning for Subareas 1 and 2 is 1-2 (Light Industrial) District (00:50 – 01:31)
