CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, PLEDGE, AND ROLL CALL (0:13 –6:21)

The Council of the City of Jackson met in a regular session on Tuesday, November 1, 2022, at 9:00 am. Mayor Scott Conger called the meeting to order, and Councilmember Paul Taylor led us in the invocation and Allegiance Pledge. The Mayor then called the roll. Councilmembers David Cisco, Johnny Dodd, Russ McKelvey, Ross Priddy, Tara Skinner, Paul Taylor, Sam Turner, and Marda Wallace were present. FIRST READING

**1. Proposed Budget Amendment - Solid Waste Recycling Convenience Center
\$65,778 (3:19 - 6:31)**

Councilmember Wallace made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dodd, to approve the agenda item as submitted. The Mayor asked if anyone had a public comment. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

2. Proposed Budget Amendment- Capital Outlay Reallocation \$0 (6:33 – 7:50)

Councilmember Cisco made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Taylor, to approve the agenda item as submitted. The Mayor asked if anyone had a public comment. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

3. Consideration of an Ordinance to rezone property located at 231 Belmont Avenue from I-3 (General Industrial) District to RG-2 (General Residential) District, comprising 2.8 acres, more or less. (7:53 – 13:11)

Councilmember Dodd made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Taylor, to approve the agenda item as submitted. The Mayor asked if anyone had comments. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

2. Proposed Budget Amendment- City Pension Fund \$10,913 (14:06– 14:21)

Councilmember Taylor made a motion, seconded by Councilmember McKelvey, to approve the agenda item as submitted. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

1.Consideration of a contract with Four Seasons for Uniforms - (14:22 – 14:46)

Councilmember Cisco made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dodd, to approve the agenda item as submitted. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

2. Consideration of a proposed dumpster enclosure, to be located at the northwest corner of the City of Jackson parking lot, near North Highland Avenue & North Liberty Street (14:47 – 26:47)

Councilmember Taylor made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Wallace, to amend dumpster enclosure location and work towards a permanent solution. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

3. Consideration of Amendment to Hotel Motel Tax Agreement (26:50 – 28:00)

Councilmember McKelvey made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dodd, to approve the agenda item as submitted. Councilmember Taylor said for public record, they have property in the area. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

4. Consideration of Resignation of Ernest Brooks II from City Council (28:02 – 28:39)

Councilmember Dodd made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Cisco, to approve the agenda item as submitted. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.

5. Consideration of Invoices over \$10,000.00 (28:40– 28:52)
