**FIRST READING**

**1. Proposed FY 25 Budget Ordinance (00:57– 1:28:03)**

Councilmember Dodd made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Lowrance to recess and go into a work session. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, except Donnell voting nay, and Holt who abstained; the motion passed 6-1-1. Councilmember Holt made a motion to reconvene a work session, seconded by Councilmember McMeen. Upon a call for vote, all voted aye except Donnell voting nay, and Lowrance who abstained; motion passed 6-1-1.

**1. Consideration of an Ordinance to amend the text of the Official Code of the City of Jackson, Title 11 MUNICIPAL OFFENSES, Chapter 5 OFFENSES**

Councilmember McMeen made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Lowrance to approve the agenda item as submitted. Upon a call for a vote, all voted aye, the motion passed unanimously.
